**Milton Roy Sheen** was born on April 20th, 1920. **Milt** lived through the depression, working on his Uncle Terence's dairy farm to make ends meet. After graduating from *Frankfurt High School* in 1937, he went to *Penn State* to study Engineering. **Milt** and **Jeanette** were married July 19, 1940. They have two daughters, **Barbara** and **Lucille**, a son, **Roy**, seven grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren. **Milt** came to Florida in the early 1950's to open a branch of his father's company—*Milton Roy Corp* and later set up his own company, *Suncoast Precision Tools* which is now run by his grandson, **Milton IV**. **Milt** joined our *Pinellas Park Rotary* in its Inaugural Year, 1954, and has had a Perfect Attendance record since then. **Milt** served our club in many areas throughout the years, including a term as our 8th President from 1963 to 1964. He was a *Paul Harris Fellow* and encouraged his daughter, **Barbara Sheen Todd**, to join Rotary. **Barbara** is our current Club President. At one time, when grandson, **Milt IV**, was a member, there were three generations in our club... father, daughter and grandson. In retirement, Rotary has been the center of his focus. **Milt** loved Rotary, all that it represents and the values that we all treasure. *Truth—Fairness—Goodwill—Public Service—Friendship.*
