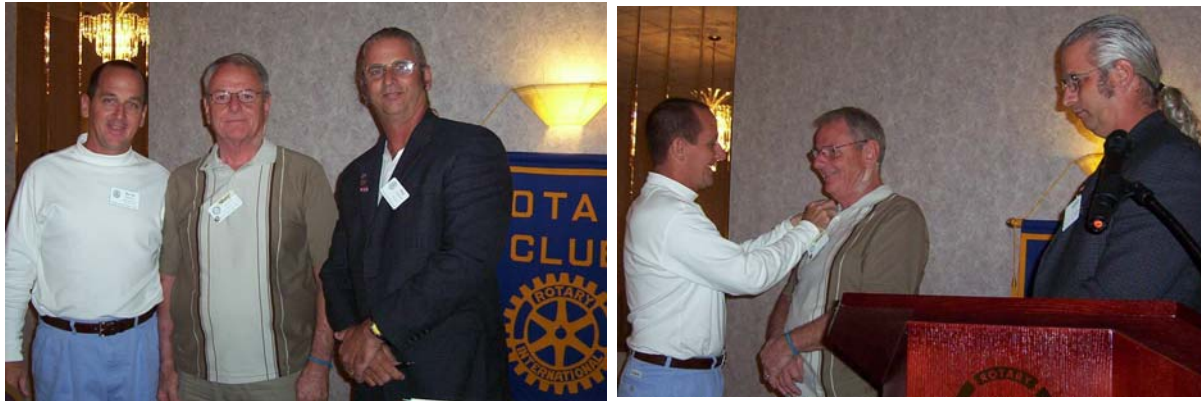

Eric spoke on the new *Health Care Informatics Degree* that is now available at St Petersburg College. Eric currently serves as an adjunct instructor for the Applied Ethics Institute at *SPC* and is a full time Project Coordinator for the Healthcare Informatics program at *SPC's* Health



Education Center. The government has mandated that all Health Care information will be totally automated with Electronic tracking by the year 2014. Eric and his staff worked with local business partners, HCA hospitals, Baycare Health Systems, Pinellas County Schools, PTEC, Pinellas County Economic Development Council and Worknet Pinellas to establish this new Associate in Science Degree program. Out of the \$1.2 million grant from the US Department of Labor, \$100,000 in scholarships will be available to students in the program.
