**This Week's Program:** Chairman, **Jerry Krauss**, will introduce **Carolyn Sironen**, a Nurse Practitioner in Dermatology since 2005. A graduate of Gibbs High School in 1983, she received her BSN from the University of Florida in 1988 and her MSN from the University of Tampa in 2001. Carolyn practices with Dr. Gary Heller on 66th Street in Pinellas Park and will speak on what their office does on a daily basis and will give us a general education on skin cancers.



**Last Week's Program:** **Joe Kolodziej** presented Deputy Chief **Ray Hanson** of the **Pinellas Park Fire Department**. Ray joined the Pinellas Park Fire Department as a fire fighter / EMT in 1981, received training as a paramedic in 1982 and functioned as a firefighter/paramedic until 1992 when he was promoted to Fire Lieutenant. In 2000, he was again promoted to District Chief / Training where he was responsible for all fire training for the department. In 2007, he was promoted to Deputy Chief of the Life Safety Management division where he currently serves as the City's Fire Marshal, responsible for oversight of fire department training, public fire safety education, fire safety inspections and construction plan review of commercial properties within the fire district. He advised us the #1 fire problem in the U.S.A is in residential homes. Over 80% of fatalities perish in homes and 66% of these are from unattended cooking and from smoking. In the last 10 years, education has increased dramatically. Ray explained the difference between Photo Electric and Ionization Smoke Alarms. One is best for smoldering fires and the other for flash fires. Everyone should have both types in the home. Unattended cooking is the largest cause of fires in the home. You should mount an alarm on top of the stove with sodium bicarbonate that makes a loud noise when it is alerted. The price range is about \$50 and is good for about 5 years. The Pinellas Park Fire Department has a free give away program with Sam's & Lowe's who donate the products if you reside in the Park. Fire department crews will come to your home and install the equipment free of charge. Just contact the Pinellas Park Fire Department.
