War On Poverty: To eradicate poverty, you must first understand it, says Deepa Willingham, founder of the nonprofit Promise of Assurance to Children Everywhere (PACE Universal), which supports the education, health and social development of girls in the slums of Kolkata, India, and elsewhere. Willingham, a member of the Rotary Club of Santa Ynez Valley, CA, USA, spoke at the 2008 International Assembly about the 1.3 billion people - known as the world's "bottom billion" - who somehow live on less than \$1 a day, and about the 10 million children every year who die before their fifth birthday because of poverty-related malnutrition.

Last Week's Program: Program Chairman, **Bruce Cloud**, presented **Dr. Don Polmann**, a member of the Tampa Bay Water System who informed us about our current water shortage. Don is a Environmental Resource Engineer in charge of regional water supply solutions for Pasco, Pinellas and Hillsborough Counties. Some of the regional accomplishments are the construction of a \$610 million master water plan, developed water and desalinated sea-water alternative supplies and reduced groundwater pumping from 147 mgd to 87 mgd. In 1998 the Tampa Bay drinking water supply was 100% groundwater. Some Surface drinking water has been introduced through the Tampa Bypass canal and the Alafia River. This water will be stored in the new 15 billion gallon reservoir Rep Bill Young helped obtain.
