Rotary news in brief from around the globe!

CANADA: Cars across the country are boosting Rotary's drive to eradicate polio. The Rotary Club of Washago and Area-Centennial, Ont., is selling car magnets with the End Polio Now logo to raise money toward Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge. The club's original goal was to sell a C\$2 magnet to every Rotarian in Canada, but word was spread and orders have come from Europe and the United States as well. Order one at www.washagorotary.ca.

CHINA: A project of the Rotary Club of Shanghai has helped train 1000 people—most of them migrant workers—to care for disadvantaged elderly people in the city. Government health managers provided one month of hand-on instruction in areas including hygiene, CPR and nursing skills. In 2008, the club donated US\$51083 toward the project, a collaboration with the Shanghai Charity Foundation.
