Last Week's Program: Program Chairman **Kevin Burkart** presented a very enlightening program on Florida building code wind mitigation. He centered his comments on single family dwellings as opposed to commercial properties. After Hurricane Andrew struck on August 24, 1992, Florida began the long process of reviewing building codes and enacted a new Florida Building Code on March 1, 2002. Florida Statue 627.0629 mandates that all property insurers provide:



“Reasonable discounts, credits, or other rate differentials...For properties on which fixtures or construction techniques were demonstrated to reduce the amount of loss in a wind-storm that have been installed or implemented.” Typical construction features that reduce wind damage and loss are roof coverings, roof deck attachments, roof to wall connections, protection of openings, doors, secondary water resistance and roof shape. As an example, structures built after January 1, 2002 are eligible for roof construction credits. Kevin gave us several examples of current policy holders that he represents that had their policies reduced from \$4485 to \$2795 and \$3433 to \$1821. These reductions were accomplished by just getting their policies written correctly. Most homeowner policies are never changed year to year even though significant construction improvements have been made. In some cases it may be cost effective to make changes to update older homes and meet new standards, thereby decreasing insurance premiums. I am sure Kevin would be more than happy to answer any questions you may have regarding this matter.

WORLD ROUNDUP...Rotary news in brief from around the Globe

Germany:

The Brocken, the highest of Germany's Harz Mountains, is famously windy. Standing atop the peak in August, participants in an international youth camp understood the force of that wind as well as its potential. The 20 young people, ages 16 to 20, had come from 11 countries to spend two weeks learning renewable energy, including solar, nuclear, bio-gas and wind power. The camp, organized by the Rotary clubs of Calenberg-Pattensen and Apringe, also included sightseeing trips to nearby Lake Steinhuder, the Weser River and the city of Hanover.
