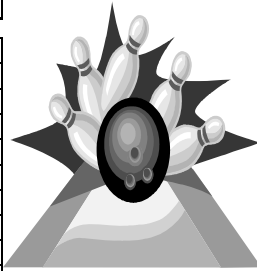

He is a highly trained career professional involved in the administrative, technical and operational management, strategic planning and organizational development of the city. Dean provided a presentation on the Public Works Academy. One of the oldest forms of skill development used in very early in America's development is that of apprenticeship training. The Public Works Academy uses Apprenticeship training for several programs. Among these are: Landscape Technician, Plant Maintenance Mechanic, Meter Repairer, Roadway Technician, Stormwater Pipefitter, Wastewater Pipefitter and water Pipefitter. Each program requires a minimum of 144 hours of related or classroom instruction and 2000 hours per year of on the job training. Upon completion, graduates receive a nationally recognized certificate from the Florida Department of Education.
