He is currently a member of the Rotary club of Largo, past President of the Belleair Bluffs Rotary Club, Chairman of the Rotary International District 6950 Disaster Preparedness Committee and Assistant Governor, Rotary International District 6950.

Last Week's Program:

Program Chairman, **Frank Torres**, introduced **Elaine Taylor** from **Family Service Centers**. The **Family Service Center** is a non-profit organization that will assist a low income family with children and poor credit move towards the purchase of a vehicle. By helping these families attain a vehicle, they assist them with holding employment, child care and it assists the parents in furthering their education. They have been helping families since the 80's and the current program has been in place since 2004. This program is funded by the Department of Transportation and the United Way. All vehicles must be inspected by a mechanic to ensure that the vehicle will last for the life of the loan. The loans range from \$2,500.00 to \$6,000.00 and the vehicle must be 10 years or newer. Elaine is looking for volunteers to be on a loan review committee for North County. Hope Peterson is presently on this committee and they meet on the fourth Wednesday of each month for about two hours. If you would like to volunteer, your job would be to review the applications and make a selection. For more information, please contact Elaine at Family Service Centers or talk to Hope.
