The appointment of Marilyn Heminger as principal of Gibbs High School in 1981, making her the first female high school principal in Pinellas County in almost 50 years, provoked skepticism in some, disappointment in others. It also landed Mrs. Heminger, who was white, in the middle of a race-based controversy. A School Board member announced he would oppose the appointment, saying Gibbs "needs the strong physical presence and the strong moral presence of a man."

While she had her share of critics, none accused Mrs. Heminger of lacking a strong presence. She survived both the Gibbs controversy and a campus shooting as principal at Pinellas Park High School seven years later. Mrs. Heminger, a music teacher who proved to critics that a woman could handle the bumps and bruises of running a high school, died March 23, of a respiratory illness at the age of 80. Marilyn was a fine Rotarian who rarely missed meetings & who attended all functions.

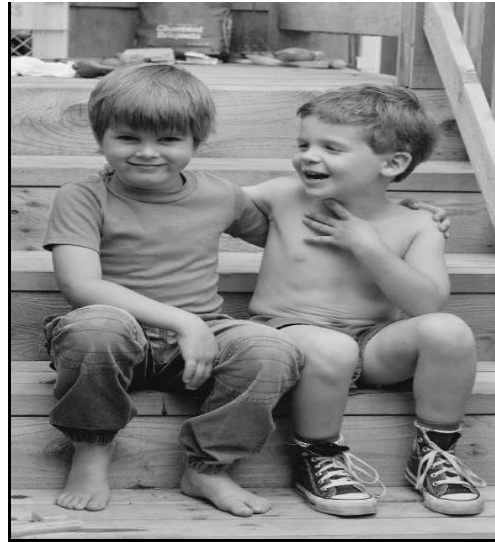

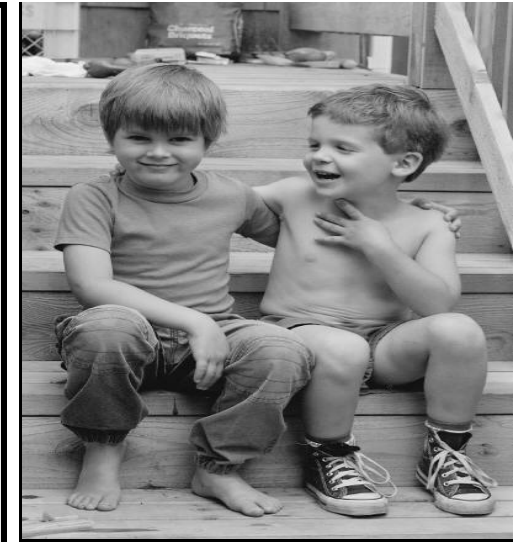
