They serve kids from kinder-garden to high school seniors. To qualify, a child must live in Pinellas County and be in financial need or in crisis. If a child is receiving free or reduced lunch through the Pinellas County School System, he or she automatically qualifies to shop at Clothes To Kids. Eligible children may shop for a complete wardrobe twice in any 12 month period. A wardrobe is 5 pair of new underwear, 5 pair of new socks, 4 bottoms, 5 tops, 1 dress, 1 pair of shoes and a jacket, All families shop by appointment. The Clothes To Kids stores are warm and cheery environments that mimic a typical "department store" ensuring every child can shop with dignity, further supporting increased self-esteem. To date Clothes To Kids has provided 45,000 wardrobes to children in Pinellas County. The need is clear 110,086 k-12th grade students are enrolled in Pinellas County schools. 49,635 (45%) of these students are eligible for free and reduced lunch, which then makes them eligible to shop at Clothes To Kids. This program is 100% privately funded and receives no government, Juvenile Welfare Board or United Way support. 60% of there donations come from individual donors and in 2009, 82% of monetary donations went directly to the Clothes To Kids program. 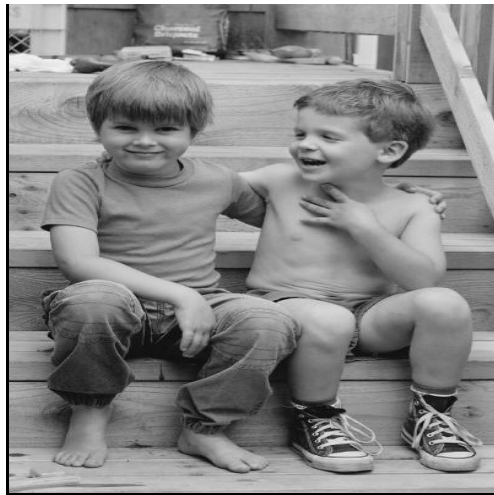
